Dear Residents:

Due to a planned replacement on Tuesday, July 16, 2024 of one isolation valve and one hydrant, **the water will be shut off to the entire town** sometime in the morning of July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024. We are expecting that service should be restored around 4:00 p.m. Also, on Wednesday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, we are replacing another isolation valve at the intersection of Aspen Street and West Road. On Wednesday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, **water will again be shut off only for the 300 & 400 Blocks of Aspen St, 200 & 300 Blocks of Poplar St, 400 & 500 Blocks of West Road and the 400 Block of Centre St. This time service should be restored around 2:00 p.m.**

We are required by the Water Security Agency to place a Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory on the water distribution system and as such, are **implementing the advisory effective at 9:00 a.m., Tuesday, July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024 for the ENTIRE town.**

Once the water is back on, you will **NOT** be able to drink it, except if boiled (please read the notice on the other side of this page), until we receive confirmation from the Provincial Lab that two consecutive days of water samples are adequate for drinking purposes. We are hoping that we can lift the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory by Saturday, July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024. A notice will be delivered to your home or business when the water is safe to drink.

You will be able to purchase water for drinking from the Water Treatment Plant pail fill as it does not flow through the distribution system and comes directly from the reservoirs. The cost is \$1 per 5 gallons.
