The LeRoy & District Volunteer Fire Department requires that any resident or individual contact the 9-1-1 dispatcher before the commencement of a controlled burn and again upon completion. A controlled burn includes, fires, grass fires, old buildings, etc. If an unreported controlled burn is responded to by the fire department, the land owner or resident will be billed at
\$1,000 PER HOUR.
